COMPETITION RULES

The competition will be conducted in accordance with WORLD AQUATICS Rules 2023-2025 in force at the start of the competition

Eligibility

All participating Federations, and Clubs representing the Federations, must be in good standing with WORLD AQUATICS and all other affiliated members.

ALL ATHLETES, TEAM OFFICIALS AND TECHNICAL OFFICIALS OF REPRESENTING COUNTRIES MUST BE FULLY VACCINATED TO BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE



Competitors who will be representing their countries must meet the following requirements:

- Demonstrate their age with proof such as what is seen on the birth certificate or Passport.
- The competitor must be a citizen, whether through birth or naturalization, of the country being represented, according to the GR-2.5 Rule of WORLD AQUATICS.
- There are no age groups, this is an open event.

Registration & Entries

- Swimmers may enter a total of three (3) individual events per day and a total of eight (8) for the entire meet. If events are not scratched by the deadline, they will automatically be dropped at the point of over entry.
- Except in relays, no substitutions or alternates will be accepted after submitting the final entries.
- All relay participants must have been entered in the meet. Relay-only swimmers must pay the facility surcharge fee. Relay-only swimmers may also swim in the Time Trials.
- In the relays, each country must enter four competitors. The order of swimmers in each relay must be submitted to the Commission Table one hour before the start of the session in which the relays will be swum.
- All events are prelims and finals except for Relays and 800 and 1500m Freestyle events which will be Times Finals.
- The pool will be open 90 minutes before each session for warm-ups.
- The warm-up routine will be an open lane format with sprint lanes taking place in lanes 1 and 8 and pace lanes in lanes 0 and 9, beginning 30 minutes before the end of the warm-up period.
- Swimmers must report to the Call Room and be in the swimmers' waiting area at least three heats before the heat or event in which they are entered.

Preliminary Entries

The attached forms must submit preliminary entries or intention to participate in PanAm Aquatics by **January 31, 2023**.

Final Entries

Final entries must be submitted to **PanAm Aquatics GMS** by **March 19, 2023**

There will be GMS video training sessions offered. Dates and times to be determined.

Final entries must include:

- a. Name of Team Officials and the position held by each official
- b. Details of arrival and departure of all athletes, team and meet officials (see attached form)
- c. Despite entry submission in electronic format on **PanAm Aquatics GMS**, a Team or Meet Manager's printout, signed by the President or General Secretary of the Federation with the Association's stamp affixed must be emailed to the Organizing Committee, by the **deadline date Sunday, March 19, 2023**. (sw2023@panamaquatics.com)



AFTER THIS DEADLINE IT WILL NOT BE POSSIBLE TO REGISTER ANY MORE INDIVIDUALS TO THE EVENT.

THE NUMBER OF REGISTRATIONS MUST NOT EXCEED THE NUMBERS SUBMITTED IN THE PRELIMINARY ENTRY.

Scratches

Scratches prior to seed of preliminary heats shall be made by properly filling out/depositing a scratch card in the scratch box located at the Resolution Table/Admin Referee table. **Scratch deadlines for May 3rd events is at the conclusion of the Technical meeting. The deadline for the remaining days is 6:00 p.m. the day before the preliminary session.**

Meet Format

Preliminaries will be swum using 10 lanes. Finals will be swum using 8 lanes

Timed Finals

The 800m and 1500m Freestyle will be conducted as Timed Finals events. The fastest 8 seeded swimmers will swim in the Finals session. All relays will be contested as Timed Finals swimming in the Finals session. Top 16 by time will score.

Finals

All individual events will be contested heats/finals format. C, B, and A Finals will be contested in that order. The C Finals will be limited to swimmers 18 years and younger that are not swimming in the B or A Final. The fastest 16 swimmers will swim in the B and A Finals regardless of age.

Time Trials

Time trials will be offered at the end of each session in the events not listed in the meet program. For athletes entered in the meet, time trial entries must be submitted each day one hour before the start of each session to the Meet Referee. An athlete may only participate in one time trial per day. Details will be given during Technical Meeting.

AWARDS AND SCORING

Scoring -16 places

20-17-16-15-14-13-12-11-9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1

Relays will score double points.



Medals

Medals will be awarded to the first three swimmers in each event. There will be no formal medal presentation ceremony, as time will not permit this. Medals will be available for pickup shortly after the event's conclusion or at the end of the day's proceedings. A commemorative backdrop will be available where swimmers may have photographs taken with their awards.

High Point Awards

- Individual High Point Award--A high point award will be presented to one female & male swimmer based on the number of points scored in their events. The presentation will take place at the end of the meet.
- National Federation Point Award--A National Federation high point award will be presented to the National Federation winner in the male & female categories based on the total number of points scored by adding individual and relay points. The presentation will take place at the end of the meet.
- Performance Award -- A performance high point award will be presented to one female & one male swimmer based on the highest number of World Aquatics Performance points scored in one event. The presentation will take place at the end of the meet.

Certificate of Participation

All competitors shall receive a certificate in recognition of their participation.

TECHNICAL OFFICIALS

Qualified individuals may apply to PanAm Aquatics to act as Technical Officials in swimming. All technical officials are expected to cover their travel and accommodation expenses. An application form be completed by the Technical Official and sent to the email address of the PAQ Technical Swimming Committee sw2023@panamaquatics.com

Team Officials

- Delegations with twelve (12) competitors or less – three (3) team officials
- Delegations with thirteen (13) to twenty-four (24) – five (5) team officials
- Delegations with twenty-Five (25) to forty-eight (48) – seven (7) team officials

Technical Meeting

A Technical Meeting will be held on May 2nd, 2023, at 7:00 pm at the PAQ Technical Committee Conference Room at the competition venue to consider the following:

1. Scratches
2. General discussion on the Competition
3. Answer queries
4. Covid-19 Protocols

DOPING CONTROL

During the competition, anti-doping control tests may be conducted, according to the control rules established by WORLD AQUATICS.

World Records and World Junior Records

As per DC 5.3.3.1, any athlete equalling or breaking a World Record in Swimming, as defined in the WORLD AQUATICS Swimming Rules, shall be tested immediately after the race, or at the latest, 24 hours after the race.

Continental or National Record

Should an Athlete equal or break a continental or a national record during the 2023 PanAm Qualifier and not otherwise be selected for testing, the member federation may request ITA / PanAm Aquatics to conduct testing on such athlete upon payment of a fee determined by ITA/PanAm Aquatics.

PROTESTS

Protests will be resolved under WORLD AQUATICS Rule GR 9.2.

Protests must be submitted to the Referee in writing by the team leader, with a deposit of US\$100, within 30 minutes following the conclusion of the respective event.

All protests will be considered by the Referee.

The commission will consider appeals against decisions by the Referee and give recommendations to the jury of appeal, whose decision will be final.

JURY OF APPEAL

For the Championships, the Jury of Appeal shall consist of a minimum of three persons and will be comprised of PanAm Aquatics Executive Committee and PanAm Aquatics Honorary Members present and the WORLD AQUATICS Delegate (if present) with the PanAm Aquatics President or in his or her absence a PanAm Aquatics Vice-President and/or PanAm Aquatics Executive Liaison for Swimming as chairman.

A jury member will be allowed to speak, but not to vote, on a case in which the interest of his/her PanAm Aquatics Federation is involved. Technical Officials and Judges for Swimming shall not be entitled to form part of the jury.

In case of urgency, the jury may vote on a matter even if it has not been possible to contact all members.

The decision of the jury will be final.



MEDICAL INSURANCE

Medical insurance is the responsibility of each athlete, coach, official, supporter, and National Federation, representative. Neither **PanAm Aquatics**, WORLD AQUATICS, nor the host nation assumes any responsibility for the medical attention of the participants.

HOTEL OPTIONS FOR NATIONAL FEDERATIONS

The **entry and participation fees** for athletes, coaches, support staff, international technical officials, and National Federation leaders include the following benefits:

- Shuttle transportation from the **Jorge Chavez International Airport** to the hotel and return to the **Jorge Chavez International Airport**.
- Bus or Minibus transportation from the official hotel to and from the VIDENA Aquatic Centre
- Breakfast, lunch, and dinner at the official hotel valid from dinner on May 1 through lunch on May 7th, 2023.
- Check in after 15:00 pm Check out before 12:00 m. Fees for special requests will be provided upon request.

Accommodation cost:

- US\$ 135.00 per night per member based on four (4) persons in a room or such a number as determined by the male/female ratio and a total number of persons in the delegation.
- If a Federation makes a specific request for accommodation other than four persons per room, the following rates will apply:

IMPORTANT REGISTRATION DATES:

- The preliminary deadline to register is **January 31, 2023**
- The World Aquatics reservation for the package is **March 19, 2023**
- **A 50% down payment must be received by March 26, 2023**
- **Federations not complying with the down payment or paying in full by March 24, 2023, will need to pay a surcharge of \$35 per person per night**

- All invoices need to be settled by **April 7, 2023**
- If a Federation misses to comply payment in full by such date, the host nation will not be obliged to provide lodging at the described fees in this summons. Reimbursements shall not apply and/or a different and higher fee may be applied.
